FOOD PROTECTION PROGRAM FEES

Effective September 16, 2008

Annual fees, effective March 1, 2006 for food service establishments, retail food stores, mobile food vendors, and temporary and special food events designated as being:

Food Service Establishment/Retail Food Store:

◆ Risk Type 1 (Low)	\$175
◆ Risk Type 2 (Medium)	\$325
◆ Risk Type 3 (High)	\$450
• Retail Grocery w/Food Prep (per check-out lane, in addition to Risk-based permit fee)	\$20

Fixed Location Seasonal (up to 6 months):

Mobile Food Vendor:

Temporary/Special Event-Non-Profit \$10

Temporary/Special Event-Profit \$30

- *Applications received less than 48 prior to the commencement of a temporary event shall be assessed a late fee of \$10.00*

Permits shall not be transferable from one person to another person, nor shall the permit be applicable to another location other than that for which it was issued.

Every operating permit shall be issued for a period of one year, April 1 – March 31, except seasonal or temporary permits, unless sooner due to revocation or suspension. A person, firm or corporation who begins a food operation after October 1st shall be required to pay only one-half (1/2) of the annual permit fee for the balance of that permit year.

The Department shall determine the risk type. The risk type shall be based on the type of food served, the extent of food preparation involved, and the population served.
